Results From the Survey 2022


We had 24 Responses. The survey took respondents an average of 6 minutes to complete





When are you most likely to attend our meetings and activities? (Please select all the times that suit you)




3. How often are you likely to attend OLGBT activities that are run at your preferred times?







9. How would you describe your gender







11. How would you describe your sexual orientation




